#### Terms of reference:

- To receive a report from the named governor on the extent to which the school and any additional services contribute to the quality of the provision and outcomes for the most vulnerable groups, including looked after children and those with special educational needs.
- To monitor communication between the college and parents.
- To make recommendations to the Governing Body in respect of the work done by this Committee.
- To receive, consider and adopt policies relevant to the working of the committee on behalf of the Governing Body of the school.
- To receive reports and consider the equality of access to rewards and visits made by students.
