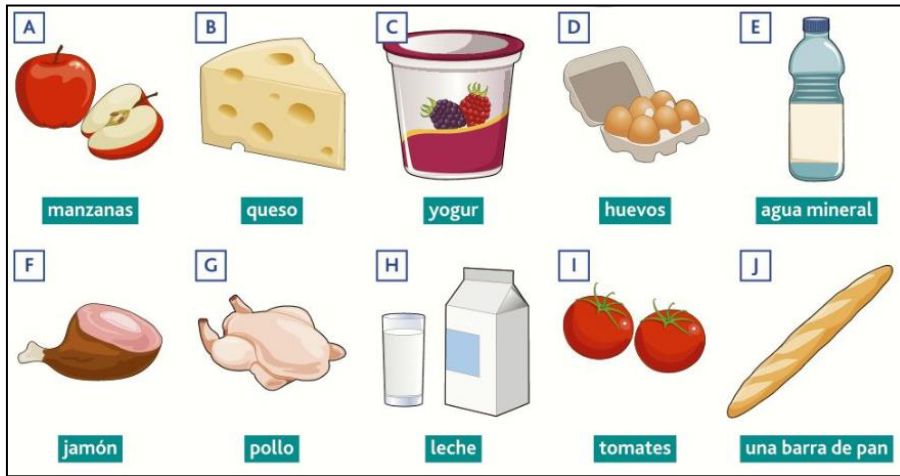

Notes

Using the future tense

The future tense corresponds to the English 'will' do something. For example 'I will go', 'They will make', 'Will you talk to her?'

In Spanish it is formed as follows:

Take the infinitive of the verb (-ar, -er, -ir) and add the following endings: -é, -ás, -á, -emos, -éis, -án

compraré = I will buy *beberá* = he / she will drink *verán* = they will see, watch
