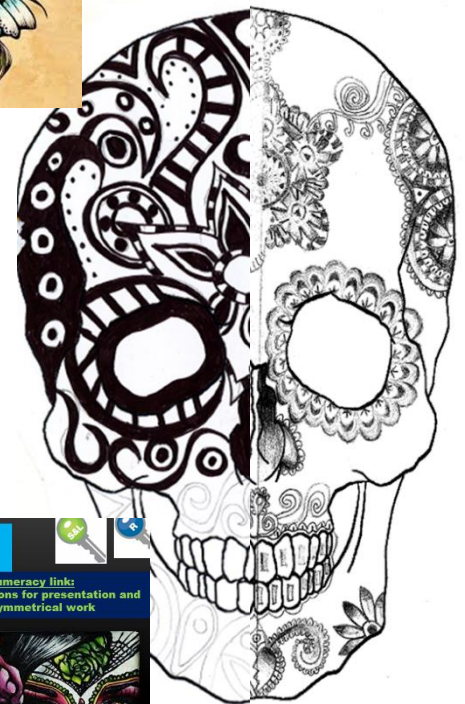
DAVID LOZEAU
