

## KS4 French - Knowledge Organiser 5 – Possessive adjectives

These are words which describe to whom something belongs – like my, your, his, her, our, your and their.

In French there are 3 words for my – one for masculine, one for feminine and one for plural.

	<b>Masc.</b>	<b>Fem.</b>	<b>Plural</b>
<b>My</b>	mon	ma	mes
<b>Your</b>	ton	ta	tes
<b>His/her</b>	son	sa	ses
<b>Our</b>	notre	notre	nos
<b>Your</b>	votre	votre	vos
<b>their</b>	leur	leur	leurs

Look at the noun and decide first if it's singular or plural. If it's singular you need to decide if it's masculine or feminine (**usually** feminine if it ends with 'e').

N.B. In French the possessive adjective is chosen depending on the object and **not** the owner,

Example: His car and Her car are both Sa voiture (because voiture is feminine)

His bike and her bike are both son vélo because it's the object and not the owner!
