- To receive reports on the extent to which the school encourages students to adopt healthy lifestyles and to keep them safe.
- To receive reports on the extent to which the school encourages students to make a positive contribution to the community and to prepare them for their future economic well-being. To encourage the community's involvement in the school
- To monitor communication between the college and parents.
- To make recommendations to the Governing Body in respect of the work done by this Committee.
- To receive reports and consider the equality of access to rewards and visits made by students.
- To receive, consider and adopt policies relevant to the working of the committee on behalf of the Governing Body of the school.
